TELL Assessment:

- I-pads have been set up for TELL
- Students' names and IDs have been entered
- Approximately 48 students and 50 licenses
- Program loaded onto 100 I-pads.
- TELL Assessment should be completed by the end of the month.

Student Data:

There was a lot of discussion on what data should be included for the pilot. We determined that at this point in the pilot, we would be unable to have a "control group" and should include only data from the Newcomers over the three year pilot.

- Goal: Consistent data over the next two years using ACCESS, DIBELS, and TELL
- Growth comparisons using ACCESS
- TELL would be used in place of 5 DP for pilot data
- Determined that the Newcomer Academy teachers should enter their students' data
- Create a document using Google Docs. Nawal offered to create the document with assistance from Maria
- Data will include Fall, Winter, Spring testing

Next Steps:

- On-line TELL training for teachers
- Complete testing by the end of October
- Val needs to know which I-pads to push it out to
- Nawal will coordinate testing

November Meeting:

- Follow-up on TELL assessment
- Discuss intervention schedules; what's working and what is not.
