MEDICAL TUTORING POLICY**

When a student is unable to attend school due to a medical issue for at least fourteen school days, he/she may be assigned a tutor. The proper Medical Tutoring form must be completed and verified by a medical professional, then approved by the principal. The assigned tutor will work with the student as a liaison between the student and the regular classroom teacher. The student will receive one hour per week in each core subject. The student will be graded by the regular classroom teacher, based on the amount and quality of work completed by the student in conjunction with the tutor. The student must pass all quarter and semester exams to get full credit.
